

## CWFF Fundraising Ideas

The participants of the 2012 CWFF Pizza Challenge submitted excellent fundraising ideas.

Their ideas earned a total of \$6,654.94 for the CWFF! *Way to go!*

*Looking for some new fundraising ideas? Use these tried and tested ideas!*

- Once a month, fill a penny bank or globe with coins
- A potluck dinner – charge admission and donate to the CWFF
- Collect coins for extra chores or odd jobs done around the house and neighbourhood
- Bottle drive
- Donate monthly dues
- Make a monthly calendar with daily tasks to be completed. Once tasks are completed, girls make a contribution to a donation jar. Calendars can serve a two-fold purpose of fundraising for CWFF and completing program-related tasks (such as environmental awareness)
- Sell extra district cookies
- Have a fashion shows complete with baked goods, silent auctions, white elephants and craft sales
- Surprise auction – auction off items wrapped in paper bags
- Christmas carolling at a seniors' home
- Campfire song carolling
- Bagging groceries at the local store
- Craft and bake sales
- Pet Parade and Dog Show, complete with categories and prizes, at the local Home Hardware
- Unit restaurants, complete with menus, tickets, silent auctions and entertainment
- Craft fairs with outside vendors
- Making and selling reusable grocery bags
- Power Save Challenge – every time a light or appliance is left on, the girls make a donation to their jar
- Friendship necklace with an attached CWFF bank
- Making and selling flower-topped pens
- Guessing how many jewels are in the Queen's coronation crown and bringing in that many coins, followed by High Tea with the Queen
- Fancy dress party called the Snowflake Ball for own and neighbouring district Brownies. Entry fee included music, 2 crafts, food and a photo
- Camp activities such as "flying" to different countries and charging 50¢ per flight
- Collecting spare change
