



JUDITH HORLEY MEMORIAL AWARD CRITERIA

This Bursary was established by Thompson Nicola Area Council (1999) in memory of Judith Horley, in recognition of her dedication and support of the Guiding movement at all levels.

OBJECTIVES

- To further promote the Mission and Principles of Girl Guides of Canada as expressed in Guiding Essentials.
- To encourage further education/training for current members of the Girl Guides of Canada – Thompson Nicola Area.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this bursary, the applicant must:

1. Currently be a registered Member of Girl Guides of Canada
2. Have been a member of Girl Guides of Canada for at least 10 years.
3. Have been a member of Girl Guides of Canada in Thompson Nicola Area, British Columbia, Canada for at least 3 years.
4. Show a commitment to Service in her school or community.

GUIDELINES

1. This bursary is conditional upon acceptance at a Canadian post-secondary institution of the recipient's choice.
2. This bursary will be awarded only when proof of registration, in the form of a receipt for tuition paid, and the recipient's Social Insurance Number have been received by Thompson Nicola Area Awards Committee – Girl Guides of Canada.
3. The bursary must be used within 18 months of notification date.
4. The recipient is to publicly acknowledge that she is the recipient of the Judith Horley Memorial Award and must agree to have her name and photograph publicised.
5. A letter of approximately 200 words or less on "The Importance of Guiding and Service in my life".
6. The recipient is encouraged to continue her involvement in Guiding in whatever way possible.

Candidates will be evaluated on the following:

- Guiding history and involvement.
- Service/volunteer involvement within Guiding.
- Additional interests and activities.
- Employment/Volunteer positions outside of Guiding.
- Confidential recommendation letters – one from within Guiding, and one from outside of Guiding.
- 200 words or less on "The Importance of Guiding and Service in my life".
